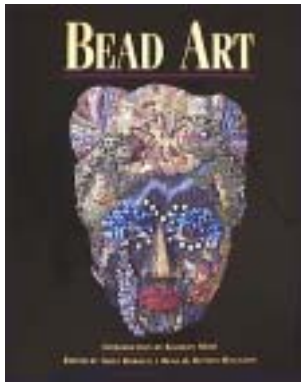

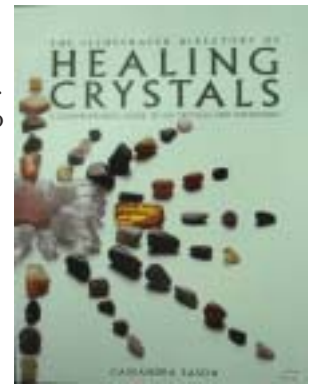


BEAD ART edited by Alice Korach, *Bead & Button Magazine* (1998: *hardcover*, 8.5x11, 110 color pages). *Bead Art* celebrates 81 works by the 54 artists selected for the first biennial *Beadworks®* Exhibition at the Dairy Barn South-eastern Ohio Cultural Arts Center. The works featured here in 117 full-color photographs represent the present and future of the beading movement. The

works of today's leading-edge bead artists are more personal than ever before, and their technical accomplishments are astonishing. Works are constructed from thousands of tiny glass seed beads, wound from molten glass rods, stitched and crocheted with wire. There are pictorial bead-woven images, heavily bead-encrusted fiber pieces, and freestanding sculptures. A few artists have even used materials other than beads. Subjects range from deeply personal statements to whimsical views of ordinary activities. **6632BK \$29.95**

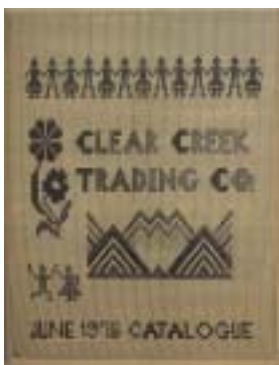

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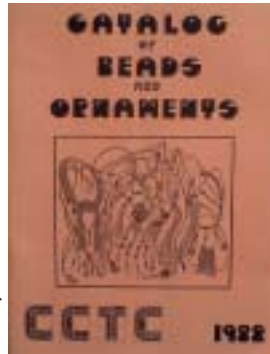
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
