**Minimum Order:** \$25.00. *There is a \$3.00 charge for under minimum orders after the first order.*

**METHODS OF PAYMENT:** (Sorry, no C.O.D.s)

**Charge Cards:** We accept VISA, MasterCard, American Express or Discover.

**Checks:** We gladly accept checks that are printed with your bank number and your name (sorry, no temporary counter checks). We also must have on file your street address or location, and your phone number. There is a \$20.00 service charge for checks returned to us unpaid by your bank.

**International Orders:** Please pay by credit card, cashiers check or money order in US dollars. Minimum International orders - \$50.00

**Shipping & handling: Free UPS Ground Shipping on orders over \$500.00.** Most orders are shipped the same day they are received. We will ship "best way" (fastest/cheapest) unless you specify otherwise ( e.g., Next Day Air, Second Day Air, Priority Mail etc.). Shipping charges vary based on the value, weight and destination. Charges include actual carrier charge, plus a \$2.00 handling fee. If you wish to pay by check, we will refund any overpayment unless you ask us to apply the credit to future orders. The average surface shipping for a one lb., \$100 order is typically \$7.00 to 8.00.

**Prepaid backorders** may be requested for items valued at \$10.00 or more. You will pay for your backorder in advance. Your backorder will then be shipped to you at *our* expense (best way).

**Published prices may be changed without notice:** Occasionally we must raise our prices on certain items as our costs increase. We also enjoy *lowering* our prices when we can.

**Return Authorizations:** If you need to return merchandise, please do so within 10 days of receipt of goods. A 25% restock fee may apply for returns after 10 days. Follow the instructions on the "THANK YOU FOR YOUR ORDER" sheet enclosed in every shipment. Sorry, **no returns on special orders, videos, books or chain cut to order or "in store" purchases.**

**Claims for damage during transit** should be made by you directly to the Carrier (UPS, Fed Ex or Postal Service). This procedure is outlined in the "THANK YOU FOR YOUR ORDER" sheet enclosed with every shipment.

**Colorado Residents only:** We are required to collect 7% Colorado State and local sales taxes from those who do not have a Colorado **State** Sales Tax License or Certificate.

**Business Hours:** Our business hours are from 9 A.M. to 5 P.M., Mountain Time (11 to 7 Eastern; 10 to 6 Central; 8 to 4 Pacific; 2 AM to 10 AM Greenwich) Monday through Friday (except major holidays) and noon to 4 P.M. Saturday and Sunday. If you call before or after our regular hours you may leave a message with our voice messaging service and we'll return your call. **Visit our showroom:** We are located 35 miles west of Denver just off of I-70 (1 hour from Denver International Airport). If you live in or are visiting Colorado, we'd love to have you visit us. Call us for easy directions. If you wish to take a purchase with you, we will need a photocopy of your **state** sales tax license. Otherwise, we are required to collect 7% Colorado State & local sales taxes on your purchase. Showroom hours are the same as our regular business hours. Please allow time for checking out.

**Organization and Use of the Catalog.** Your catalog has tabbed dividers (**General Info, Applique, Books, Glass Beads**, etc.) arranged in alphabetical order that indicate the types of materials or items found in that section. Each section has its own page numbering in the upper left hand corner, including the date of issue. Most sections have a Table of Contents at the beginning to assist you in locating specific items. Of course, if you have difficulty locating anything in the catalog or have any other questions, please call us and we will be happy to help you.

There is a tabbed divider named **Supplements**. New Items Supplements and Bulletins are issued to inform you of new items that are available. Periodically, information in Supplements is integrated into the appropriate Catalog sections which are then mailed to you to keep your catalog up to date. Please remember that the most recently published information takes precedence over information published earlier.

**IMPORTANT:** When ordering by mail, please use the entire item number, including the 2 letter suffix, description and page location. Use the entire page number designation, such as **(4/02 Sup-1) April 2002 Supplement — Pg-1**, when ordering from a supplement.

**Do Your Own Testing.** We cannot be responsible for a material's suitability for a particular application. Most glass bead coatings are stable and durable, but generally are of unknown chemistry and age, and should be approached accordingly. Therefore we urge you to do your own testing where coated materials, as well as acetates (sequins) or other plastics, might be subjected to washing, dry cleaning, or sun exposure. See Pg. 5, Definitions of Terms, for a list of terms that designate surface coatings. Also not all cements or adhesives are suitable for some applications, particularly foil or mirror backed imitation stones.

**Stock Limitations.** We specialize in stocking items that are rare and unusual and therefore limited in quantity. For this reason, there will always be items in our catalog which are sold out, even in the most recently published sections. Therefore, when continued availability of one of our items is critical to your productions plans, we urge you to inquire as to stocks we have on hand. Also, contemporary beads are produced in relatively limited editions, depending on market demand. From batch to batch, even the "same" bead is likely to vary in color tone. Keep this in mind when planning your productions.

**Samples.** We know there are times when it is difficult to visualize exactly what an item looks like. Although we describe and illustrate or photograph our merchandise and provide a glossary of colors, you may wish to see the actual piece. If a particular color tone, texture, finish, etc. is critical to your project, we recommend you order samples before ordering in quantity. This can save you the cost of returning unsuitable merchandise and allow you to compare items for compatibility. There may be a charge for samples depending on the item or number of items requested. **Samples and sample cards are not returnable or refundable.**

**Specifications in Ordering.** Underlined words indicate choices of color, size or style that need to be made when ordering. If you forget to make such choices where necessary and we are unable to contact you, we will either ship on the basis of what we can reasonably infer from the rest of your order or previous orders, or not send that item at all. For example, if you have ordered several findings in gold rather than silver, we would ship gold for an item on the same order where no choice was indicated.

**Gift Certificates!** We offer Gift Certificates in any amount over \$35.00. Gift Certificates are a good way to avoid having to make a decision about what to give somebody for a special occasion or just to say thanks for any reason. There is no "fee" and we will mail the certificate to you or directly to the individual to whom you are giving the certificate. There is no charge for postage or handling for the certificate, but we will apply shipping and handling to any order placed using the certificate.
