

## Tumbled Stones

We have a very nice, limited quantity of polished stones that were tumbled in Idaho Springs by a business that began operation in the 1940's and ran major production through the 1970's. Collected for their quality & color, most were mined in Colorado, Wyoming, Utah, New Mexico, Arizona and Mexico. Some stones are rare treasures. All have been warehoused for several decades and some of the stones may no longer be available for mining. We have about 30 types of these stone left. The chart on page 9 lists the stone names, stock numbers and price groups and the sizes still available. The illustrations below detail the size ranges and approximate number of pieces per lb. There will be some crossover between the sizes.

### Mixed Stone Pendants

These tumbled stones were capped with gold or silver filigree bell caps. Assortments may include aventurine, various agates, amazonite, amethyst, Apache tear, chalcedony, crystal quartz, rhodonite, feldspar, gold sheen obsidian, gold stone, jade, jaspers, palmerwood, petrified wood, red jasper, rose quartz, snowflake obsidian, tigereye, turritilla and youngite.
