STRUNG BLACK COCQUE FEATHERS

Long slender iridescent greenish feathers are 4 to 6 inches long and are sewn together to make about a 3 foot length of dense, luminous fringe that will weigh 2 to 3 ounces. **\$6.00 oz**



750NF Golden.

Skin is rich red and brilliant orange, with some dark blue, various shades of tan and brown, and iridescent rich olive green edged in black (12x17 in). **\$7.50 ea**



753NF Ringneck.

Skin is reddish bronze, gold, rust, plum, peacock-green and peacock-blue with iridescence in many areas (12x10 in). **\$12.00 ea**
